

Agreement for Students Receiving Financial Aid (FA)

Initially the entire \$350 team fee will be granted. It is expected that FA recipients will make monetary contributions to reduce the amount of aid received whenever possible. This can be in the form of contributions from others (friends, relatives, neighbors, etc.) to Westview Robotics.

Recipients are expected to participate in all fundraising activities with the goal of bringing in to the team at least the amount of the financial aid received.

Dedication of time to the team needs to be demonstrated by the student. A minimum commitment of three (3) days per week (or 50% of the available [150] work hours – usually between 50 and 80 hours) at team meetings is required during build season.

Optional travel fees (typically \$50) may be granted for student performance on the Pit Crew or Drive Team based on observations of Team Captain, Head Coach and Head Mentor.

Travel costs to FIRST World Championships (typically \$1,100) will not be funded unless student is elected to the Drive Team based on observations of Team Captain, Head Coach & Mentor.

Grant writing and reviewing documents takes a lot of the Mentors' time. Assistance with this task benefits the entire team and makes it possible to grant financial aid to those who need it. Participation in these activities is required. Coordinate with Head Mentor or Business Mentor.

Parents may fill volunteer positions on the team when needed. A partial list is:

- Mentors: engineering, programming, business, PR, animation, SPIRIT, to name a few. Some companies donate \$\$ for your volunteer time.
- Travel Coordinator for OOT Competition events: out of town travel (light rail, buses), hotel, Amtrak train, airplanes, meals, sightseeing, etc.
- Transportation Coordinator: local car pools to events, demonstrations.
- Administration: coordinate meeting times, place, agenda, forms, etc.
- Clothing Coordinator: t-shirt order & disbursement; jacket order, purchases, embroidery & disbursement to Mentors and Students.
- Google Group Moderator: moderate discussions, maintain daily updates, send notices.
- Fundraising: Chairperson/Coordinator needs a person to learn/take over from him.
- Crowd Control: need daily to oversee Study Hall room, help Students stay focused and engaged, provide Safety help in shop as needed.
- Chaperones: primarily for travel; we have a 3:1 student/chaperone ratio; only pay 1/2 of travel costs (nothing if sufficient fund raising is done before travel event).
- Volunteers at Oregon City, Portland, Wilsonville events we attend.
